### IMPORTANT IRRIGATION DRAIN INFORMATION

On the outside of your irrigation system, you have either a plug or a spigot on your backflow that shuts the water off from your system to your house. When we come out to drain/winterize your system – if you have a plug, we will remove it, and leave it in a plastic bag and secure it to the

backflow. If you have a spigot, we will leave it in the open position. Any water that is left in the system after the draining is done will drip out and prevent the backflow from freezing.



**IMPORTANT** – Before you start your system in the spring – put the plug back in place on the backflow and/or close the spigot to prevent water gushing when the system is activated. Turn the water on **SLOWLY!**
